Dear Gaia-FUN-SSO member,

\* A meeting on the Gaia Follow-up (not only SSO..) is organized in Marseille, France, on April 11th (see <http://www.imcce.fr/~thuillot/Suivi-sol-Gaia/>) . This is focused on the French participation, in particular from the Haute-Provence Observatory. But, this meeting is open to everybody (who is able to come in Marseille...). \* 99 942 Apophis: we have now collected a large amount of images of 99 942 Apophis. The involved stations have the MPC codes: 71, 89, 119, 300, 511, 585, 910, A84, B04, B17, C01, D20, Z20 and the Lijiang station. Several more (MPC code 188 and 586) are still awaited. This represents more than 3200 measures. The analysis is in progress and we are confident to reach interesting results upon the dynamics of this PHA. We are still interested by collecting more observations. Do not hesitate to send them to us, we intend to submit a collective article to a journal on this topic. Collecting your images is important in order to provide an homogeneous analysis. I will give you a mean to upload them on our ftp if you are concerned.
